"What shall I say? He hath spoken unto me, and Himself hath done it Behold, for peace (Ephesians 2:14) I had great bitterness, but <u>Thou hast</u> in love for my soul delivered me from the pit of corruption: for <u>Thou hast</u> cast all my sins behind Thy back . . . !"

Isaiah 38:15-18 and ref: Ezekiel 36:25-36

Quote -

"From eternal ages it was God's purpose* that every created being, from the bright and holy seraph to man, should be a temple for the indwelling of the Creator. *But* because of sin, humanity ceased to be a temple for God. Darkened and defiled by evil, the heart of man no longer revealed the glory of the Divine One. But . . . by the incarnation of the Son of God, the purpose* of Heaven is fulfilled. God dwells in humanity, and through saving grace* (G5485 – the divine Influence upon) the heart of man becomes again His temple."

Put Me in remembrance: let us plead together . . . declare thou, that thou mayest be justified*!"

"Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD . . . though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; *yea*, though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool . . . !"

"And in those days, and in that time, saith the LORD the iniquity of Israel shall be sought for, and there shall be none; and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found. For I will pardon them whom I reserve . . . !"

Who against hope, believed in hope* (in confidence, assurance that God verily cannot lie – Hebrews 11:6), that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken **And he staggered not** at the promise of God <u>through unbelief</u>; but was strong in faith, giving *the* glory to God.

And being fully persuaded . . . that what He had promised, He was able* (full of Divine power) also to perform. And therefore it was imputed* (reckoned, counted) unto him as righteousness . . .

Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him, but for us also . . . To whom it

shall be imputed* (counted, reckoned) . . . if we believe on Him that raised up Jesus our Lord (Sovereign King) from the dead . . . Who was delivered* (surrendered, given up) for our offences, <u>and was raised again</u> for our justification . . . !"

"Therefore . . . being justified* by faith, we now have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. By Whom also . . . we have received the atonement (at-one-ment)!"

note: Not striving to BE, not trying to BE . . . but believing that we ARE, because He hath spoken it, and therefore it is so "Today," if we "will but hear His Voice . . . !"

II Corinthians 6:2 and Hebrews 3:7-19

"Because as He is (I Am), so ARE we in this world . . ."

Justified

Justification (H6663, G1344, G1347, G1342) = to render, to declare just, innocent, clean, holy, righteous!

"I write unto you, little children, because your sins <u>are</u> forgiven you for His name's sake . . . And He is the <u>propitiation*</u> (G2434, 2435, 2433 – atonement, atoning victim, reconciliation, lid of the ark of the testament, mercy seat) for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world . . . !"

I John 2:12, 2

"Behold the Lamb of God . . . which taketh away* the sins of the world!"

John 1:29

"If Thou, LORD, shouldest mark* (observe, hedge about, record, keep record of) iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand? But there is forgiveness* (to give in exchange for – II Corinthians 5:21) with Thee, that Thou mayest be feared (Micah 7:18-20) . . .

I wait for the LORD, *yea*, my soul doth wait, <u>and in His Word</u> (Christ Jesus – John 1:14) <u>do I hope</u>* (have confidence, assurance) . . . and I know that I shall not be ashamed! . . . my soul waiteth for the Lord* (the Messiah, My King) more than they that watch for the morning: I say, more than they that watch for the morning . . .

Let Israel hope* in the LORD (Galatians 3:8-14) . . . for <u>in the LORD</u> shall all the seed of Jacob be justified* (declared innocent), and shall glory! . . . for with the LORD there is mercy, and with Him is plenteous Redemption. And He shall redeem* Israel from all his iniquities . . .!"

Psalm 130:1-8 and Isaiah 45:22-25

"O Who is a God (*Elohim* – Mighty One) like unto Thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by (over) the transgression* (rebellions, apostasies) of the remnant of His inheritance? He retaineth not His anger for ever, because He delighteth in mercy . . .

He will turn again (cause His Face to shine – II Corinthians 4:3-6), He will have compassion

upon us . . . He will <u>subdue our iniquities</u> (*in His Own flesh* – Romans 8:2-4); and **Thou wilt cast all their** (our) **sins** into the depths of the sea. Thou wilt perform Thy Truth (John 17:17) to Jacob, and Thy mercy to Abraham, which Thou <u>hast sworn</u> unto our fathers from the days of old . . . !"iHi

Micah 7:18-20

"To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember His holy Covenant . . . yea, the Oath which He sware unto our father Abraham . . . that He would grant* (a gift, non-repayable) unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand (power) of our enemies, might serve Him without fear, in holiness and righteousness before Him (in His Presence), all the days of our life . . . !"

Luke 1:67-75, Titus 3:5-6 and II Timothy 1:9

"Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood (Romans 8:2-4), He also Himself likewise took part of the same *flesh and blood* . . . that through death (dying unto sin – Romans 6:10), He might destroy him that <u>had the power*</u> (dominion, right, rule) of death, that is the Devil . . .

And deliver them (us) who through fear of death (dying and not rising again), were all their lifetime subject to bondage . . . !"

Hebrews 2:-15 and ref: Matthew 11:28

"Behold, the days come, saith the LORD . . . that I will make a New Covenant* with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah (ref: Micah 7:18-20 and Luke 1:67-75). Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand [to elope] to bring them out of the land of Egypt . . . which covenant they brake (Jeremiah 3:1-23) although I was an Husband unto them . . .

"For they got not the land in possession by their own sword (Ephesians 6:17), neither did their own arm save* them (ref: II Timothy 1:9 and Titus 3:5-7)... **But Thy Right Hand**, and Thine Arm, and the Light of Thy Countenance (II Corinthians 4:3-6), because Thou hadest a favor* (to satisfy a debt) unto them ...!"

Psalm 44:3 and ref: Zechariah 6:12-13* Isaiah 31:1, 16:5 and 32:15-17

"And it was about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour . . . and the sun was darkened, and **the veil of the temple** was rent in the midst. And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, He said . . . It is finished!" Luke 23:44-46, John 19:30

Finished (G5055, G5056) = levy paid to the uttermost, debt paid in full!

But this shall be the Covenant (promise, Oath) <u>that I will</u>* make with the house of Israel (Galatians 3:29), after those days, saith the LORD . . .

I will put My law (Romans 8:2-4) in their inward parts, and <u>I will</u> write it in their hearts . . . written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the Living (Life-giving) God; not in tables of stone, but in the fleshy tables of our heart (II Corinthians 3:3).

And <u>I will</u> be their God (Mighty One), and they shall be My people . . . for <u>I will</u> forgive* (give in exchange for) their iniquity, and <u>I will</u> remember* (mark, keep record of, recount, bring to remembrance) their sin no more!"

Jeremiah 31:31-34, Hebrews 8:10-12

"By the which WILL (John 1:13) . . . we ARE sanctified* (made holy – I Peter 1:15-16), through the offering* (Romans 12:1) of the body of Jesus Christ (unleavened), once for all !"

Hebrews 10:10 and I Corinthians 5:7*

"For by one offering* (bloodless sacrifice), He <u>hath perfected</u>* for ever, them that ARE sanctified. Whereof, *the gift of* the Holy Spirit is a witness unto us (*that He has cleansed His temple of our bodies* – ref: Desire of Ages, p161): for after that He had said before . . .

ref: John 7:37-39, Acts 2:31-39 and Galatians 3:10-14

Quote -

"God's ideal for His children is higher than the highest human thought can reach. "Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect" (Matthew 5:48). **This command is a promise**... accepted by the will, and received into the soul (heart), it brings with it the Life (John 6:63 and John 14:10-11) of the Infinite One!...

The plan of redemption contemplates our complete recovery from the power of Satan. Christ always separates the contrite soul from sin. He came to destroy the works of the devil, and He has made provision that the Holy Spirit shall be imparted to every repentant soul, to keep him from sinning."

"For after that He had said before . . . This is the Covenant (promise, Oath) that I will make with them after those days, saith the LORD, <u>I will</u> put My laws (Romans 8:2-4) into their hearts, and in their minds <u>will I</u> write them. And their sins* (sideslip, to err, habitual sinfulness) and iniquities* (perversities, mischief) will I remember* no more . . . !

Having therefore brethren, boldness (by His merits and worthiness alone) to enter <u>into</u> the holiest by the blood (*Life – Leviticus 17:11*) of Jesus . . . by a new* (recently slain) and living way (John 14:6), which He hath consecrated* <u>for us</u> (John 17:19), through the veil, that is to say, His flesh . . . !

And having an High Priest over the house of God . . . which house we are . . . Let us draw near with a true heart, in full assurance of faith (Isaiah 32:15-17), having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure Water . . . Let us hold fast the profession of our faith in Him (Romans 10:8-13) without wavering, for He is Faithful that hath promised!"

Hebrews 10:12-23, Hebrews 3:6 and John 15:3

"For if, when we were yet enemies, we were reconciled* to God (ref: Desire of Ages, p.160-161) by the death of His Son, much more, BEING now reconciled (II Corinthians 5:18), we shall be SAVED by His Life . . .

And not only so, but we also joy (*rejoice* – Zephaniah 3:14-20) in God through our Lord (King) Jesus Christ, by Whom . . . *the world <u>is</u> crucified unto me, and I unto this world* . . . and **by Whom** we have now received the atonement!"

Romans 5:10-11 and ref: Galatians 6:14

"Reconciliation* means that every barrier between the soul and God is removed, and that the sinner realizes what the pardoning love of God means (Romans 3:26). By reason of the sacrifice made by Christ for fallen men, God can justly pardon the transgressor who accepts the merits of Christ. Christ was the channel through which the mercy, love, and righteousness might flow from the heart of God to the heart of the sinner. "He is faithful and *He is* just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness!"

In the prophecy of Daniel it was recorded of Christ that He shall "make reconciliation* for iniquity, and . . . bring in everlasting righteousness" (Daniel 9:24). Every soul may say: "By His perfect obedience He has satisfied the claims of the law, and my only hope is found in looking to Him (Isaiah 45:22-25) as *both* my Substitute and my Surety (guarantee), Who obeyed the law <u>perfectly</u> for me.

By faith in His merits <u>I am now free</u> from the condemnation* of the law . . . "What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, then who can be against us? He that spared not His Own Son, but delivered Him up in exchange for us all (Romans 5:12-19), how shall He not with Him also freely give* us all things? (Romans 8:31-32 and Isaiah 50:7-8) . . .

He clothes me with His righteousness (Zechariah 3:1-5), which answers all the demands of the law. I am complete in Him (Colossians 2:10), Who brings in everlasting righteousness. He presents me to God in the spotless garment of which no thread was woven by any human agent. All is of Christ, and all the glory, honor, and majesty are to be given to the Lamb of God, which taketh away* the sins of the world!"

Quote -

"There are many who claim to be children of God who are resting their hopes upon other dependencies, <u>rather than on the blood</u> (Life) <u>of Christ alone</u>. When urged to rest their faith wholly upon Christ as a complete Saviour, many reveal the fact that they have faith in something that they think they can do.

They say, "I have a great deal to do before I can be fit to come to Christ." Another says, "When I have done to the uttermost all that I can do, then the Lord Jesus will come to my help." They imagine that they have a great deal to do themselves **to save their own souls**, and that Jesus will come in <u>and piece out</u> that part which is lacking, and give the finishing stroke to their Salvation (freedom, deliverance, healing and restoration).

These poor souls will not be strong in God until they accept Christ as a complete Saviour. They can add nothing to their salvation . . .

The Israelites were required **to sprinkle the door-posts** with the blood of a slain lamb, in order that when the angel of death passed through the land, they might escape destruction. But if, instead of doing this simple act of faith and obedience, they had barricaded the door, and taken every precaution to keep the destroying angel out, their pains would have been in vain, and would have testified to their unbelief . . .

When the blood was seen upon the door-post, it was enough. The Salvation (rescue, freedom, deliverance, healing and restoration) of the house <u>was assured</u>. **So it is in the work of Salvation** (ref: John 8:34-36); it is the blood of Jesus Christ that cleanseth from

(blotteth out) all sin!

"For in that He died, He died unto sin once (Philippians 2:5-8), but in that He liveth . . . He liveth unto God. Likewise, reckon ye also (count it as verily so) yourselves **to be dead indeed** unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord (Sovereign King) . . . !"

Romans 6:10-11 & 6:1-6

It is not now the work of the sinner to make peace with God, but to accept Christ as his Peace and Righteousness . . . *for God hath declared it* . . . Thus man becomes one with Christ (John 17:21) and <u>One with God</u> (*at-one-ment*). There is no way by which **the heart** may be made holy, save through faith in Christ.

Quote -

"The grace of Christ is freely to justify* the sinner without merit or claim on his part. Justification is a full, complete pardon of sin. The moment a sinner accepts Christ by faith, that moment he <u>is</u> (*I am*) pardoned. The righteousness of Christ is imputed to him, and he is no more to doubt God's forgiving grace.

Quote -

"As a result of Adam's disobedience (Romans 5:12), every human being is a transgressor of the law, sold under sin. **Unless he repents and is converted**, he is under bondage to the law (Romans 6:16 and Romans 8:2-4), serving Satan, falling into the deceptions of the enemy, and bearing witness against the precepts of Jehovah. But by perfect obedience to the requirements of the law, man is justified!

Only through faith in Christ is such obedience possible. **Men may comprehend the spirituality of the law**, they may realize its power as a detector of sin, but they are helpless to withstand Satan's power and deceptions . . . unless they accept the atonement* provided for them *by faith* in the remedial sacrifice of Christ, Who is our Atonement--our At-one-ment--with God."

I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy transgressions* (rebellion, and apostasies): return unto Me, for I have redeemed thee . . . !" Isaiah 44:21-23, 49:14-16 Quote -

"In his restless youth the prodigal looked upon his father as stern and severe. How different his conception of him now! So those who are deceived by Satan look upon God as hard and exacting. They regard Him as watching to denounce and condemn (Hosea 6:6), as unwilling to receive the sinner so long as there is a legal excuse for not helping him.

His law they regard as a restriction upon men's happiness, a burdensome yoke from which they are glad to escape (Romans 8:7-8).* **But he whose eyes have been opened** by the love of Christ will behold God as full of compassion. He does not appear as a tyrannical, relentless being, but as a Father longing to embrace His repenting son. The sinner will *then* exclaim with the Psalmist, "Like as a father pitieth his children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear Him." Psalm 103:13-14.

In the parable there is no taunting, no casting up* to the prodigal of his evil course. The son feels that the past is forgiven and forgotten, <u>blotted out forever</u>. **And so God says** to the sinner, "I <u>have</u> blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy transgressions, and, as a cloud, thy sins," Isaiah 44:22. "I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember* (mark, keep record of) their sin no more . . .!" Jeremiah 31:34.

"And Jesus answered and said unto her . . . If thou only knewest the GIFT of God (Isaiah 12:1-6), and Who it is that saith unto thee, Give Me a drink; thou wouldest have asked of Him, and He would have given thee living (Life-giving) Water . . .

But this He spake of the Spirit, which they that believe on Him (the Word and Promise of God) should receive . . . !" John 4:10-24 and John 7:37-39 and Acts 2:33-39*

"For Zion's sake will I not hold My peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest (cease, desist), until the (their) righteousness thereof go (shines) forth as brightness, and their Salvation (freedom, liberty, healing) thereof as a lamp that burneth . . .

For as a young man marrieth a virgin, so shall Thy sons* (children begotten of) marry Thee . . . for we are the bride of Christ, clothed freely with the wedding garment of His righteousness . . . and as the Bridegroom rejoiceth over the bride, so shall thy God rejoice over thee . . . !"
