## The Father's Love for You!

"The LORD (Jehovah, *Yehuwah*) hath appeared of old unto me, saying, **Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love**: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee!" Jeremiah 31:3

"For GOD (The Almighty) commendeth (demonstrated) His love toward us, in that, <u>while we were yet sinners (in open rebellion, and hating Him)</u>, **Christ died for us**!" Romans 5:8

"And Jesus (*Yehushua*) spake this parable unto them, saying . . . . A certain man had two sons: and the younger of them said unto his father, Father, give me the portion of goods (mine inheritance) that falleth to me. And he (the father) divided unto them his living.

And not many days after, the younger son gathered all together and took his journey into a far country, and there <u>he</u> wasted his substance with riotous living (devoured thy living with harlots). And when he had spent all, there arose a mighty famine in that land; and he began to be in want. And he went and joined himself to a citizen of that country; who sent him into his fields to feed swine. *ref: Luke 15:30* 

And he (the boy) would fain (longed for and desired to) have filled his belly with the husks that the swine did eat: and no man gave unto him. And *then* when he came to himself, he said, **How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare**, and I perish with hunger!

I will arise and go to my father . . . . And he arose, and came to his father. But while he was yet a great way off, his father saw him coming, and had compassion (sympathy, tenderness, mercy), and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him!

And the son said unto him, Father, I have sinned **against heaven**, and in thy sight, and I am no more worthy to be called thy son! **But the father said** unto his servants, bring forth the best robe (Christ's perfect righteous-ness), and put it on him; and put a ring on his hand (the symbol of an heir to the kingdom), and shoes on his feet: and bring hither the fatted calf, and kill it; and let us eat and be merry . . . .

For this my son (or daughter) was dead, and is <u>alive again</u>; he (and she) was lost, and now is found!"
Luke 15:3, 11-24

And Jesus said unto them, "What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine in the wilderness, and go after that *one* which is lost, until he find it? And when he hath found it, he layeth it on his shoulders, rejoicing!

And when he cometh home, he calleth together his friends and neighbours, saying unto them, Rejoice with me; for I have found my sheep which was lost!

I say unto you, that likewise **joy shall be in heaven over one sinner** that repenteth (turns around, and comes home to GOD), more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance!

Likewise, I say unto you, there is joy in the presence (in the midst) of the angels of GOD over one sinner that repenteth (turns and cometh home)!"

For "**the LORD** thy God <u>in the midst</u> (heart) of thee **is Mighty**; <u>He will save</u> (deliver, set free, rescue, heal and restore thee whole),

He will rejoice over thee with joy, He will rest in His love,

He will joy over thee with singing!"

Zephaniah 3:17

"Know ye that the LORD (Jehovah, *Yehuwah*) He is God (*Elohim* - The Almighty One): it is He that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people, and the sheep of His pasture!"

Psalm 100:3

"I Am the good Shepherd: and the good Shepherd giveth His Life for the sheep!" John 10:11

Forgive\* = to give for (to give in exchange for).

"Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and **I will give you rest**! Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I Am meek (gentle, humble) and lowly in heart, and ye shall find Rest (Sabbath) for your souls!" Matthew 11:28-29

"Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down His Life for His friends!" John 15:13

"And in this was manifested (and clearly shown) the love of GOD toward us, because that GOD sent His Only-Begotten Son into the world, **that we might Live** (rise to walk in newness of Life) *through faith* **in Him**!"

I John 4:9

"For GOD (Jehovah, *Yehuwah*) so loved (had affection and attachment for) this world, that <u>He gave up</u> His Only-Begotten Son, that **whosoever believeth** (trusteth) **in Him**, should not perish, but have everlasting Life!

For GOD sent **not** His Son into the world **to condemn** the world; but that the world <u>through Him</u> **might be saved** (delivered, set free, rescued, healed and made whole)! **He that beliveth on Him** <u>is not condemned</u>: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the Only-Begotten Son of GOD!"

John 3:16-18

**Jesus** = (*Yehushua*), Jehovah saved, Jehovah's Salvation!

"For as by one man's disobedience (Adam's) many (largely, altogether) were made sinners, **So by the obed-ience of One** (Christ Jesus) **shall many be made righteous** . . . . For if by one man's offense (transgression), <u>death</u> (and sin) <u>reigned</u> by one; <u>how much more</u> <u>shall</u> they which receive (<u>by faith</u>) **abundance of Grace** and <u>the</u> <u>gift</u> of Righteousness, Reign in Life by One, Jesus Christ!"

Romans 5:19, 17

"In His days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is His name whereby He shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS!"

Jeremiah 23:6

"And she shall bring forth a Son, and thou shalt call His name JESUS (*Yehushua*): for <u>He shall save</u> His people from their sins!"

Matthew 1:21

"For He is our God; and we are the people of His pasture, and the sheep of His hand. **Today, if ye will hear His Voice, harden not your heart** . . . !"

Psalm 95:7-8

"And therefore will the LORD wait, *so* that He may be gracious unto you, and therefore will He be exalted (raise again from the dead), **that He may have mercy** <u>upon you</u>: for the LORD is a God of judgment (justice): Blessed are all they that wait for Him!"

Isaiah 30:18

"For He saith, **I have heard thee** in a time accepted\*, and in the day of Salvation have I succoured (rescued and delivered) thee: **Behold**, **Now** is the accepted time; behold, **Now** is the day of Salvation!"

II Corinthians 6:2 & Isaiah 49:8-9

"For all things are of GOD (Jehovah, *Yehuwah*), Who <u>hath reconciled</u> us to Himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry (service, work for others) of reconciliation! To wit (for it was in this manner) that GOD was <u>in Christ</u>, reconciling the world unto Himself, **not imputing** (taking inventory, reckoning, accounting) **their trespasses** (errors or willful transgressions) **unto them**; and He hath committed unto us *also* the Word of reconciliation . . . .

**For He hath made Him to be sin** <u>for us</u>, Who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of GOD in Him (Christ Jesus)!"

II Corinthians 5:18-21

"But Zion (Jehovah's people) said, The LORD hath forsaken me, and my Lord (*Adoni*) hath forgotten me! Can a woman forget her sucking (nursing) child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? Yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee!

**Behold, I have graven thee** upon the palms of My hands; thy walls (your home) are continually before Me!"

Isaiah 49:14-16

"For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a Root (the Root of Jesse) out of <u>a dry ground</u> . . . Then said He unto me, Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel: behold they say, Our bones are dried, and our hope is lost . . . He hath no form nor comeliness (there is no physical attributes to attract us); and when we shall see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. ref: Ezekiel 37:1-11

For He is despised and rejected of (by) men; a Man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid

as it were our faces (in shame) from Him. He was despised, and we esteemed (took not His defense) Him not! **Surely He hath borne** (to lift, taken away) **our griefs** (malady, calamity, sickness, disease), **and carried our sorrows** (anguish and affliction): yet we did esteem Him (that He was) stricken, smitten of God (The Almighty), and afflicted!

'But say unto them that are of a fearful heart,

Be strong, fear not: For Behold, your God (*Elohim* - Mighty One) will come . . . Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.

Then shall the lame *man* leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb *shall* sing: for in the wilderness shall Waters break out, and Streams in the desert . . . !' Isaiah 35:4-6, ref: John 7:37-39

For He was wounded for our transgressions (rebellions), He was bruised (beaten repeatedly) for our iniquities (perversity, mischief): **the chastisement of** (the discipline which bought) **our Peace was upon Him**; and with His stripes (wounds and bruises) <u>we are healed</u>!

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD (Jehovah, *Yehuwah*) hath laid upon Him **the iniquity** (perversity, mischief) **of us all**!"

Isaiah 53:2-6

"Remember these, O Jacob (deceiver) and Israel (he that prevails with GOD); for thou art My servant: **I** have formed thee; thou art My servant: O Israel, thou shalt not be forgotten of Me. **I** have blotted out (to erase, abolish, utterly wipe away), as a thick cloud, **thy transgressions** (rebellions), and as a cloud, thy sins (offenses, failures, and habitual sin): Return unto Me; for I have redeemed thee!

"... So shall My Word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: It shall not return unto Me void, but It shall accomplish *all* that which I please, and It shall prosper *in the thing* whereto I sent It. For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with Peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands ...!"

Isaiah 55:11-12

Sing, O ye heavens; for the LORD hath done it: Shout, ye lower parts of the earth: break forth into singing, ye mountains, O forest, and every tree therein: For the LORD hath redeemed Jacob, and hath glorified Himself in Israel!"

Isaiah 44:21-23

"To whom GOD would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is **Christ in you**, the hope of Glory!" Colossians 1:27

"For thus saith the LORD, Ye have sold yourselves for nought (nothing); but ye shall be **redeemed** without money!"
Isaiah 52:3

"Out of the depths have I cried unto Thee, O LORD. Lord (*Adoni* - Sovereign King), hear my voice: let Thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications. If Thou, LORD (Jehovah, *Yehuwah*), shouldest mark (observe, keep record of) iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand? But there is forgiveness with Thee, that Thou mayest be feared. I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in His Word do I hope!

My soul *waiteth* for the Lord (*Adoni* - Sovereign King) more than they that watch for the morning: I say, more than they that watch for the morning. Let Israel hope in the LORD: for with the LORD there is mercy, and with Him is <u>plenteous</u> **redemption**. And He shall redeem (rescue, ransom, release, deliver) Israel from <u>all</u> his iniquities!"

Psalm 130:1-8

"Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD (Jehovah, *Yehuwah*): **though your sins be as scarlet**, <u>they shall be as white as snow</u>; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool!"

Isaiah 1:18

"For who is a God (*Elohim* - Mighty One) like unto Thee, **that pardoneth iniquity**, and that passeth by the transgression (rebellions) of the remnant of His heritage? For He retaineth not His anger forever, because **He delighteth in mercy**. He will have compassion upon us; **He will** subdue our iniquities; And Thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea."

Micah 7:18-19

"For I, even I, am He that blotteth out (erases) thy transgressions for Mine own sake, and  $\underline{I}$  will not re-member thy sins."

Isaiah 43:25

"For the LORD (Jehovah, *Yehuwah*) is merciful and gracious, He is slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. He will not always strive: neither will He keep his anger forever. He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor has He rewarded us according to our iniquities.

For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His mercy toward them that fear Him (hold Him in reverence and awe). As far as the east is from the west, so far hath He removed our transgressions from us. Like as a Father pitieth His children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear Him. He knoweth our frame; He remembereth that we are dust."

Psalm 103:8-14

"When I consider Thy heavens, the work of Thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which Thou hast ordained;

What is man, that Thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that Thou visitest him?

For Thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and *yet Thou* hast crowned him with glory and honour!"

Psalm 8:3-5

"But GOD (The Almighty), Who is rich in mercy, for His great love, wherewith He loved us (which He has demonstrated unto us), Even when we were *yet* dead in sins, <u>hath</u> *He* **quickened us** (raised to New Life) togeth-er with Christ (The Anointed One), for <u>it is by Grace</u> (the Divine Influence upon our hearts) **that we are saved** (delivered, protected, rescued, set free, healed and made whole).

And <u>He hath</u> raised us up together with His Son, and made us to sit together in heavenly (the most holy of) places in Christ Jesus: That in the ages to come **He might show** the exceeding riches of His grace and kindness toward us through Christ Jesus (Moshiac Yehushua)!"

Ephesians 2:4-7

"What shall we then say to these things? If GOD (*Yehuwah* - The Almighty Father) fights for us, who then can be against us? For He that spared not His Own Son, but yielded Him up for us all, How shall He not

with Him also **freely give** (grant favor, kindness, pardon, deliver, forgive) us all things?

Who shall lay any thing (accusations) to <u>the charge</u> of GOD's elect (against those **who have been chosen by the Most High**). <u>It is GOD that justifieth</u> (make righteous). Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ (*Moshiac* - The Anointed One) that died, yea rather, that is risen again, Who is even now at the right hand of the Almighty.

It is He Who also maketh intercession for us!

Romans 8:31-34

'And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven,

Now is come Salvation, and Strength, and the Kingdom of our GOD,
and the power of His Christ (*Moshiac* - Anointed One): for the accuser of our brethren
is cast down, which accused them before our GOD day and night!'

Revelation 12:10

Who shall be able to separate us from the love of Christ (The Anointed One)? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or the sword? As it is written, For Thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are counted as sheep for the slaughter . . . .

Nay, in all these things we are more than Conquerors through **Him that loves us!** 

For I am persuaded that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities (the rulers of the darkness of this world), nor powers (forces and rulers), nor things present, nor things to come. Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, **shall be able** to separate us **from the love of GOD** (our Father in heaven), which is in Christ Jesus our Lord (*Adoni* - Sovereign King)!"

Romans 8:31-39

"This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope, It is of the LORD's **mercies** that we are not consumed, because **His compassions fail not**. They are <u>new</u> every morning: Great is Thy faithfulness!"

Lamentations 3:21-23

"For if thou shalt <u>confess with thy mouth</u> the Lord Jesus (*Adoni Yehushua*, He is Sovereign and King), and *thou* shalt believe in thine heart that GOD (Jehovah) hath raised Him from the dead, **thou** <u>shalt be</u> Saved (delivered, rescued, set free, healed and made whole). For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto Salvation . . . !

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord (Adoni - The Sovereign King) shall be saved."

Romans 10:9-13, Joel 2:32

"All that the Father giveth *unto* Me, shall come to Me, and he that cometh to Me, I will in no wise cast out!"

John 6:37

"Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth My Word, and believes on Him that sent Me, has

everlasting Life, and shall not come into condemnation; but <u>is passed</u> from death unto Life." John 5:24

"And all these are written, that you might believe that Jesus (*Yehushua*) is the Christ (Anointed Heir and King), the Son of GOD and that believing you might have Life through His name." John 20:31

"And **this is the will of the Father** that sent Me, that everyone which seeth the Son, and <u>believeth</u> on Him, may have everlasting Life: And <u>I will</u> raise him up at the last day!"

John 6:40

"Blessed be the LORD God (*Yehuwah Elohim*) of Israel; For He <u>hath</u> visited and Redeemed His people. And He hath raised up an Horn (Mighty One) of Salvation for us in the house of His servant David; As He spake by the mouth of His holy prophets, which have been since the world began. That we should be saved (delivered, rescued, set free) from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us!

'Shall the prey be taken from the mighty (ghibore - tyrant, strongman), or the lawful captive delivered? But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty <u>shall be</u> taken away (set free), and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered . . .

For I will contend with him, that contendeth with thee, and <u>I will</u> save thy children!'

ref: Isaiah 49:24-25

... To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember **His holy Covenant**; **The Oath** which He sware to our father Abraham!"

Luke 1:67-75

"For as many as received Him (accept, take hold of), to them gave He power (privilege, liberty, right and freedom) to become the sons (children begotten) of GOD, even to them that believe on His name!"

John 1:12

"Believe in His name ..."

What does that mean?

Jesus (Yehushua) means = Jehovah (Yehuwah) is Salvation! Yehuwah's saves!

What does "Saved or Salvation" mean?

**Saved means** = Rescued, protected, delivered, set free, healed, and made whole!

The greatest lie that Satan (*the Accuser*) has told mankind, is that our Father is unmerciful, exacting, intol-erant, unloving, and that He cannot forgive to the uttermost! Satan then plants the seed of doubt, fear,

resent-ment, bitterness, hatred and rebellion within our hearts. So that we become like him . . . . without hope!

All of Scripture tells one story, how a Father's children were poisoned against Him. And His great work of fighting for and delivering them from the hand of the great enemy (the Devil, that great liar). Our Loving Father in heaven is the Almighty! He is the Great I AM THAT I AM. He that spoke the worlds into existence, Can, and will with one single Word, speak

"Forgiven!"

And it is done! . . . In a single moment, darkness becomes Light, guilty becomes pure, and through faith, the dead rises to walk in newness of Life. And from that point onward, we are clean. Our sins, our guilt, our past is no more! The Life of Yehushua (Jesus) His Son covers us, not as a blanket covering some dirty secret, but as Water, His life and His Spirit wash through us. Cleansing us from every defilement. Making us new creations in Christ Jesus. We are now and forever the sons and daughters of the Most High!
